Caryl Picker began her artistic studies at Finch College and continued with such renowned instructors as the Art Students League and Parsons School of Design. Private instruction with such notables as Will Barnet, Leon Kroll, Harold Castor and Jim Youngman have all helped pave the way to Caryl's achievements.

Her sculpture and jewelry are filled with personal style and symbolism, displaying her preoccupation with movement, and an intense rhythm of line. Caryl translates her understanding of dance and the nature of the human body into pure and fluid sculpture.

The day begins at 10:30 am at Patsel's Restaurant with a kosher brunch catered in the private dining room by Gourmet Caterers. We then go to Caryl's studio for a wine reception and personal presentation of Caryl's work.
